KNBT renamed as National Penn

BOYERTOWN – National Penn Bank has announced that its KNBT community offices in Schuylkill County have been renamed as National Penn community offices.

They include the offices in Pottsville, Schuylkill Haven and Shenandoah.

In a National Penn press release, **Michael Reisman** said National Penn, including its KNBT division, is the fourth largest bank holding company based in Pennsylvania. KNBT is the largest division of the organization, with 50 offices throughout Lehigh, Northampton, Carbon, Luzerne, Monroe and Schuylkill counties.

“Because many of KNBT’s customers ... already benefit from using National Penn offices in Berks County, it was reasoned that the renaming in Schuylkill County was a natural change that simply expanded the National Penn name along the Route 61 corridor,” Reisman said in the release.

“The KNBT name will continue to serve our customers in Northeastern Pennsylvania,” said **Dave Kennedy**, group executive vice president and chief delivery officer of the National Penn general bank. “Customers may continue to conduct business in any National Penn community office, or at our other member banks: KNBT, HomeTowne Heritage Bank and Nittany Bank.”
